

Will Deed

- **Applicant Presence**
The applicant must appear in person.
- **Passport & Resident Card**
Original passport and Oman Resident Card must be presented for verification.
A self-attested copy of the passport and Oman Resident Card must be submitted.
- **Will Deed Document**
Original Will Deed along with a photocopy must be submitted.
- **Witness Requirement**
The presence and signatures of two witnesses are mandatory for the execution of the Power of Attorney.
Both witnesses must appear in person at the center and present their original passports and Oman Resident Cards for verification.
- Affidavit formats are available on the website for reference. Applicants are required to choose the applicable format as per their request and submit the duly completed and signed affidavit along with the supporting documents.

Note:

- This service is available only at the Muscat Center.
- A Will Deed is a legal document in which a person declares how their assets and property should be distributed after their lifetime.
- All details must be accurate and consistent with supporting documents.
- Original documents will be verified and returned after processing.
